In addition, *Full Spectrum Solutions, Inc.* provided **full-spectrum, energy-efficient lamps** to make indoor lighting easier on the eyes and the energy bill, and *Bluworld Innovations, LLC* donated a **waterwall** to support the natural décor.

NESCAUM has also been supplied with **aromatherapy oils** from *AromaWerks, LLC* for office fun and wellness, and has gone **fair trade** with its coffee supply, thanks to *Sweetwater Organic Coffee Company*.

NESCAUM is currently investigating the potential of creating a rooftop green garden for its office building that can help clean the outdoor air by removing pollutants and cooling city temperatures.
